## **BECCLES & BUNGAY RC SHOW RULES**

Hard hats must be worn at all times whilst mounted & must conform to safety standards BS14474/6473 or PAS015.

Horses must be 4 years and over in all ridden classes.

Show canes & whips must not exceed 70cm.

Rider's ages taken from 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.

Judges will not ride exhibitors' horses.

Competitors may only enter a maximum of four show jumping classes.

The organisers have the right to split or amalgamate any class at their discretion.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry or to substitute a judge without notice. The judge's decision is final.

No dogs allowed on the showground.

Objections must be given in writing with a deposit of £10 to the secretary within 10 minutes of the end of the class. The deposit will only be refunded if the complaint is upheld.

The organisers accept no responsibility in respect of any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horse, owner, rider or spectator or to any property whatsoever.

No refunds after closing date without a veterinary certificate.

### **CLASSES 12 & 29 TARRA In hand & Ridden**

(Thoroughbred & Retired Racehorse Association)

Open to all Wetherby Registered Thoroughbreds raced or unraced. (Passports will be checked) 4 years and over. Ideally racing names of horse should be used. Class 11 judged as normal In Hand. Class 27 judged as Riding Horse without 'type'. Injuries caused during racing will be overlooked. These are qualifiers for TARRA In Hand & Ridden Championships to be held in September 2011. First two will qualify and pass down the line to 4<sup>th</sup> only.

### **CLASS 18 All-rounder pony & horse**

To be judged on presentation, turnout, manners and way of going.

Competitors will be required to jump a small course of not less than 3 fences, not exceeding 60cm (2' approx) and to perform a short individual show to include trot, canter.

The entry will be judged on its suitability and potential as a true all-rounder.

Showmanship and etiquette of the rider will be included.
