SENIORS

There were 23 teams entered. Blidworth EQ won with West Oxon RC coming second.

The team finished in sixteenth place but all thoroughly enjoyed the experience. The atmosphere was brilliant with everyone mucking in and helping and supporting each other. This is what riding club is all about.

There were good performances from our team members with some competing at the Championships for the first time.

Sam Palmer picked up 4 faults in the show jumping and went clear on the cross country but collected 8 time penalties for being under the optimum time. This gave Sam 24th place individually.

Lucy Frost gave another outstanding performance going clear in both the show jumping and cross country. However the partnership was also too fast cross country and collected 24.3 time penalties. Lucy finished 59th individually.
